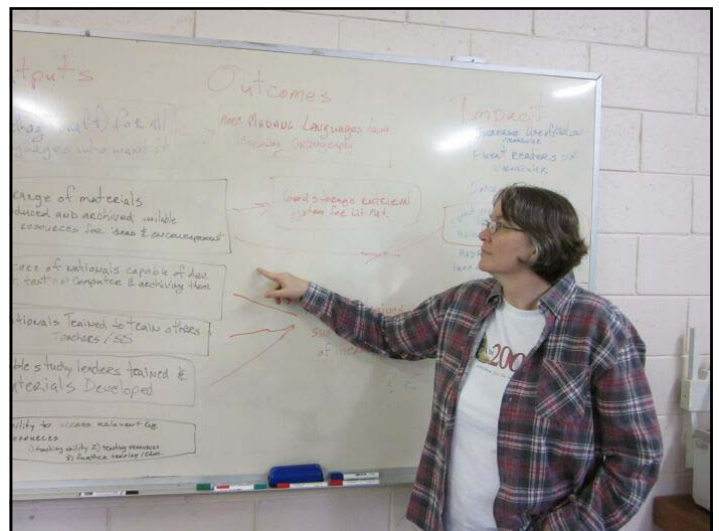
Dear NCCC,
